Mary Frances Forrester was narrowly defeated for National Committeewoman, but was wholeheartedly supported by Gaston County. Most issues were hotly contested by approximately 400 delegates who opposed the GOP leadership and the GOP platform. The majority prevailed on most issues.

At Convention, it was stressed that one of the most important NC elections is for the Newby Seat on the NC Supreme Court. Justice Paul Newby must be re-elected to maintain a conservative Court. We have to get name recognition out for him in Gaston County.

Obama has 2 paid staffers in their office in Gastonia and are already working the phone banks.
