GASTON COUNTY REPUBLICAN PARTY EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING

OFFICERS REPORTS

Secretary: The Minutes from the July meeting were emailed to the Executive Committee and were available at the meeting. The Minutes were approved as presented.

Treasurer: Treasurer Edward Dunlap reported a balance July 1, 2013 of \$21,244.63. We had an income of \$200.00 and disbursements of \$151.87, plus bank service charges of \$2.00. The balance on July 31st was \$21,290.76. An opening balance of \$21,290.76 was reported on August 1, 2013. There was no income or disbursements, but there was a bank service charge of \$2.00. The balance on August 31st was \$21,288.76. There is \$5,000.00 in the Building Fund.

GUEST SPEAKER: Chairman Grant, without objection, allowed the night's guest speaker to move his message to the top of the agenda so that he would be able to leave before the Committee discussed its business. Dr. Mark Harris spoke to the Committee about his decision to seek the Republican nomination for U.S. Senate for North Carolina in 2014. He noted that Senator Kay Hagan has been very weak and has voted along Democrat party lines with every decision. He explained that his reasons for running include offering a clear contrast to the liberal candidate, making sure NC's Marriage Amendment remains the law of the land, and to work toward a better America for future generations.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT:

Chairman Grant called for volunteers to assist with moving the items out of the old headquarters in Gastonia to our storage unit. He also made note that Edwin Peacock's campaign was looking for volunteers who might be willing to assist him in his campaign for Charlotte Mayor.
